Emissions will be limited by the permit to the Generic PSEL level for all pollutants except VOC which is set at the source-specific level accounting for the level requested by the applicant:

PM = $\underline{24}$ tons per year; PM10 = $\underline{14}$ tons per year; PM2.5 = $\underline{9}$ tons per year; NOx = $\underline{39}$ tons per year; CO = $\underline{99}$ tons per year; VOC = $\underline{48}$ tons per year; GHG = 74,000 tons per year.

None of these emission limits, <u>except VOC</u>, exceed the Significant Emission Rate (SER) established by Lane Regional Air Protection Agency (LRAPA).

The following table presents maximum allowable emissions of criteria pollutants for the facility. The current emission limit reflects maximum emissions the facility can emit under the existing permit. The proposed emission limit reflects maximum emissions the facility would be able to emit under the proposed permit.
